All-State Honors Ensemble Official Application Form

Requirements

1. In addition to this form, you must submit a letter from your local Superintendent of Schools, Principal, or Board of Education, stating that, if selected, the group has permission to attend and perform at the All-State Music Festival and In-Service Conference in January. If selected, the performance should not exceed 25 minutes of music.
2. Groups should submit three copies of the performance of the ensemble (the performance should not be more than one year old) and elementary groups should submit a video recording of the ensemble (the performance should not be more than one year old), along with three sets of unmarked scores of the pieces being performed. Do not send photocopies of the scores unless an official letter of permission from the publisher accompanies them. Failure to do so result in the ensemble being disqualified. Any engineering, editing, or tampering in any way with the audition recording is expressly prohibited.
3. There should be nothing on the recording or scores (markings, names, announcements, etc.), which would identify your group to the audition team (this is a totally blind audition process). Please check your scores and recordings thoroughly. Violation of this rule will result in the ensemble being disqualified.
4. The ensemble director must be a member in good standing of NMMEA and must be the director at the time of the All-State performance.
