## Hand-clapping Game:

4 students standing in a circle, palms touching, arms raised in a W position. Partners are across from each other.

Touch palms together on every chi, and backs of hands on every pa. During the verse partners take turns switching places. During the instrumental on the recording they may freely move, or I told them to find new groups, and then be ready to start the hand-clapping again when the singing resumes.
