- 8. Musical theatre: Musical theatre /Broadway repertoire is officially adopted as part of the solo and ensemble festival so that students who are planning on majoring in theatre and musical theatre can have adjudicated festivals as part of their high school careers.

- Location: possibly La Cueva, Albuquerque Academy, or a local church discussion of challenges with scheduled times, bus conflicts, and middle school scheduling needs – possibility of extending one day of MPAF into the evening for high school

- Adjudicator Recommendations: Please email adjudicator suggestions to Angelynn Gomez and Ryan Hatch by October 5, 2018. Amend suggests adjudicator Susie Parker from Ártesia, Mika Proctor from Lincoln Middle School in RRPS or Becky Talbott
 - Angelica Facio Can time on stage with clinician be reduced? Clarissa Clark enough time is needed for judges to write comments – Farris Collins moves that 17min be used for clinic, 3 min. for writing comments
- Reminder of new budgetary procedures: To avoid raising the fee and be able to utilize 3 performance judges and 1 sightsinging judge
 - We will hire one performance judge that covers all of the days of the festival, whether 2 or 3 days in length.
 - We will supplement sight-singing judge and two performance judges (one middle school/one high school, preferably) with APS choral directors who uses professional leave for the duty day and are then paid at a rate of \$60/hour outside of the 6.5 hour standard APS duty day. This also provides the ability for PDP development as instructional leaders within the district.
 - Fees were increased by \$11 per ensemble to cover the cost of plaques for ensembles who score a superior or excellent rating. New rate is \$161 per ensemble.

NMAA State Choir Contest: V. Sue Cleveland High School, April 5-6, 2019 – ensembles will be grouped by level and placed on specific days, students must remain eligible from semester through the contest. For more information, please speak with your school's activities director and NMAA.
