Educator Clinic Synopsis

A Gratitude Attitude: Finding Gratitude in Ever-Changing Times

• Vanessa V. Casarez is a Neonatal Nurse Practitioner currently practicing in Albuquerque, NM, working in the NICU at Presbyterian Hospital. Vanessa has spent the past 20 years in the NICU but most recently has completed a post-graduate certification and received her certificate as a Certified Professional Coach as well as a certification as a Health and Well-Being Coach. Vanessa's personal focus is on improving and maintaining the health and well-being of individuals, as well as helping those find and utilize the resources they have in order to live a more complete, enriched, and fulfilled life. Her current focus is on preventing burnout in the workplace and at home, and helping the groups she works with find a healthy balance between the two.

Conducting Gesture as a Musical Model

• In the heat of the moment, we often forget to rely on one of our most efficient teaching tools—our hands. A conductor's gesture is a valuable instructional tool that can be utilized throughout the learning process, often streamlining the rehearsal by eliminating verbiage. In this session, Dr. Taylor will provide focused and straightforward tips for increasing the efficiency and expressivity of the conducting gesture, along with creative ideas for its implementation within the choral rehearsal.

The Ins and Outs of the Booster Organization: Helpful Tips for the Music Educator

• The purpose of this presentation is to shed light on how to oversee and operate a music booster organization. Topics will include organization operation procedures, recruiting, bylaws, fundraising and working with parents, alumni and other patrons.

Middle School Choir MythBusters

• In this clinic, we will discuss common Middle School Choir misconceptions and how we can work around them. Subjects range from age and behavior to navigating vocal faults to some tips to look for repertoire appropriate for the level. Come gather and share ideas to use in our classroom! Open discussion and sharing of ideas will also be facilitated.

Sight Singing & Solfège - Small Steps to Success

• This session will give participants some ideas on creating success for your students in the area of sight reading. Paul will share his thoughts on how to begin with younger students as well as more advanced students. He will cover solfege, hand signs, rhythm reading, preparing for all-state auditions and MPA Festivals. Come ready to sing!

Middle School Madness in the Choral Classroom

• Beth Thomas will give various tips of how to teach "bell to bell" with innovative ideas to keep middle school choir students engaged and learning. The emphasis will be on the use of hand chimes to teach many concepts that will enhance their singing.

Picking Solo Rep. for the High School Singer

• This session will help you with the often frustrating task of assigning solo literature for contests or competitions. How do you make appropriate choices for your students, given the widely varied levels you encounter in your choral groups? We will explore how to make healthy, inspired choices

beyond the standard 24 Italian Songs & Arias to build confidence and success in your student singers.

The Basics of Multi-Styles String Playing

• The Basics of Multi-Styles String Playing – Summary: In effort to meet the diverse backgrounds of all students within an orchestral classroom, string educators have been looking towards expanding repertoire to include multiple styles and genres. However, many teachers may be hesitant to incorporate these new ways of musicking due to lack the experience, knowledge, or skills. This session will introduce the basics of multi-styles to give string teachers the tools implement a multi-stylistic curriculum. Repertoire choices, pedagogical considerations, technological needs, and instrument techniques will be discussed through a variety of string settings (beginning through advanced high school). Styles that will be discussed include jazz, mariachi, R&B, rock, and American fiddling, among others genres.

Band Directing for the Textbook Over-thinker

• In this presentation we'll discuss what overthinking is, and what it can look like in and out of the band room. Overthinking can take shape in different ways, and we all react differently to the stress that it can cause. Once we explore the characteristics of overthinking and the effect it has, we'll dive into strategies on dealing with that stress in a healthy way. Ultimately, the goal is for you to be a better and happier band director for your program. Veteran teachers are encouraged to share their stories.

Visually Cleaning a Marching Show

• No matter the size or scope of your marching band program, the need to establish a comprehensive visual curriculum is one that cannot be ignored. Through this session we will explore ideas to improve how to clean a marching show from the visual perspective. This is a two part workshop, with part 2 discussing the concepts from a musical perspective.

Teaching Musical Nuances during Marching Band

• No matter the size or scope of your marching band program, creating a holistic music curriculum is key. Through the session we will explore ideas on how to bring the musical nuances of the indoor concert ensembles to the marching field!

Small Program? No Program? No problem! Changing the rebuilding process from a daunting task to a rewarding opportunity

• Very few music educators walk into a large, perfectly designed, and supported dream program. Whether it is a small, rural area, underfunded school system, low SES population, a position with a high rate of turnover, or all of the above, excellent programs can rise up where they didn't previously exist! Laying the foundations for success in a 'less than ideal' situation can seem daunting, but can be exceptionally rewarding. In this clinic, we will break down strategies to build, rebuild or redesign a music program that will meet your educational philosophy, support the growth and development of your students, and be an active asset in your school community. Topics discussed will include: Refining your philosophy, short and long term planning, making the best use of your resources (and advocating for more), structuring curriculum, fostering student and community buy-in, keeping a productive mindset, and more!

Collaboration with MS Feeders - Roundtable discussion

• In a panel discussion with seasoned educators from both Middle and High Schools we will discuss ideas and practices that have proven effective in keeping students engaged in their musical journey from middle through high school.

Starting Double Reeds Any Time!

• In this session we will discuss the best methods to start oboe and bassoon players in your band, regardless of grade. Whether you teach middle school or high school, this clinic will help you begin those double reed players and set them up for success!

Playing by Ear and improvisation for the non Jazz Band

Playing by ear and improvising are not just for jazz band! Come and learn quick and easy ways to
incorporate playing by ear and improvisation into the concert band setting. Attendees will be
provided with practical strategies that can be implemented right away with middle and high school
students.

Breathing together: Music Educators Imagining and Co-conspiring in Times of Strife

• This session, informed by research, will create space for music educators to pause, notice, imagine, and co-conspire (breathe together) through various modes of guided reflection, in solitude and in community, on what is true in this moment and what is possible for the future of music education and beyond.

Creating Meaningful Movement Opportunities

 Movement encompasses a need for self-awareness and cultural understanding. Through movement students work toward a deeper sense of unity that helps to enhance community development in the classroom. We will look at creating meaningful opportunities for students to engage in movement and dance.

Crossing Boundaries: Growing music culture through cross-curricular instruction

 This session discusses how to grow positive music culture, increase enrollment, and establish interdepartmental collegiality throughout the school through the use of musical cross-curricular instruction. Attendees will leave with lesson plans that can be immediately implemented in the classroom, and an increased appreciation for the universality of music as an instructional and creative subject.

MLT, it's as easy as ABC!

• At its core, music learning theory is simply an attempt to explore and explain how we learn to understand music. Beginning with the listening vocabulary and moving through speaking/singing, audiating/thinking, reading, and finally writing, she will present a series of songs, chants, and activities that demonstrate this fundamental learning sequence.

Popular Music in the General Music Curriculum: A Framework for Practical Applications

• Incorporating popular music into the general music curriculum has gained traction in secondary schools due to the pedagogical, motivational, and equitable opportunities it provides to students.

This session will provide a framework for a nine-week general music course that utilizes contemporary music as a basis for music learning through the artistic practices of the National Standards of Music Education (creating, performing, and responding).

Sing, Say, Dance, Play: It's All About the Process

• The presenters will begin with a song and lead the attendees through activities in which they sing, say, dance, and play through imitation, exploration, and improvisation; essential elements of the Orff Schulwerk process.

Tips On Playing And Teaching Ukulele

Participants will learn to improve their ukulele playing and teaching skills using the ukulele as an
accompaniment instrument and also as a melody instrument in playing solos and ensembles.
 Sequential curriculum for teaching the ukulele class will be presented. Participants are encouraged to
bring their ukuleles to the session.

How to Recruit Like a Pro

• This clinic will cover topics such as: How to capture the excitement and thrill of music to recruit more students, establishing first impressions, materials to market your program, preparing props, pre-visit, student involvement, concert programing to promote and grow your program, and many other tips for success.

Analyzing String Instrument Playing Skills to Improve Repertoire Selection

• How can we best select repertoire based on the string instrument playing skills that our students have, are refining, and need to develop? These decisions are more important than ever as our orchestra students come back together after the variety of teaching modalities during the pandemic. Teachers will be able to immediately implement these tools and strategies to meet their students where they are, work to develop playing skills and refine strategies through repertoire. During this session we will adapt the Playing Skills Checklist (Gillespie, Teaching Music Through Performance in Orchestra, vol. 2) to best prepare our students for success using backward design for repertoire planning and sequence of skill development. We will also analyze playing skills in common string orchestra pieces and evaluate their listed and published grade level to make more informed decisions for repertoire plans for the school year and beyond!

Tuning issues solved: From Pegs to Fine Tuners

• Learn to repair your own instrument (and that of your student's) so you can perform with confidence. You will come out of this session with practical, hands-on experience knowing how to diagnose and correct all common tuning issues from stuck pegs or out of round peg holes to the frozen fine tuner screw or busted tailpiece gut. I'm Steve France and I've been repairing instruments since 1995 and I promise to bring what little humor I have, a bit of sarcasm, tons of real-life stores you'll repeat to students every year of the rest of your life and the large quantity of energy I bring to each day to make this an effective and fun session. You will talk about this being the most practical and applicable session of the conference! If you have a string instrument with some problems, BRING IT! There's nothing like the satisfaction of taking care of an issue yourself! From this session you will be able to address common peg issues, know when it's stuck versus out of round and how to correct it. You, and every one of your students will benefit greatly from this practical, hands-on

session. All participants will receive the free online emergency repair guide offering you hundreds of tips and tricks on how to get any student with any problem on stage fast! Make this your best conference ever by attending this session by Repair Masterclass.

Demystifying the Sight Reading Process

• Although mastery of sight-reading skills is an essential component of musicianship, our band, orchestra, and choir students are often intimidated by the prospect of sight-reading. This presentation will outline a year-long approach to teaching sight-reading fundamentals, including strategies for incorporating sight-reading practice into the daily rehearsal plan. Whether you are preparing for an adjudicated contest or simply looking to build a basic skill set, a focus on sight-reading will yield accomplished, independent musicians capable of performing a wide variety of repertoire.

All Strings Attached- Strategies to Build a Successful Middle School Orchestra Program.

• Take a look at how I approach classroom procedures, warm-ups, concert programming, scaffolding, and writing in the orchestra classroom. Bring your instrument for interactive learning!

Classroom Guitar Before, During, and After COVID

During the pandemic, teachers developed creative ways of teaching classroom guitar. Many
pedagogical techniques used prior to the pandemic were modified to accommodate situations
brought on by COVID restrictions. Some of those modifications can still be applied when the
students return to classrooms full-time. This session will present some of those techniques, including
blended learning. Methods of using blended learning, whether students are in class daily, at home, or
in-class part-time, will be presented. Unique blended learning curriculum and courseware will be
made available.

New Music Reading Session

• Explore new ensemble music for guitar classes. Sample score and parts provided by 'Musicality' and available for purchase. Bring your guitar to sight read selections. Level-Intermediate/Advanced High School Guitar Classes.

Teaching Guitar for the Non-Guitarist

• This session will offer insight to help the 'non-guitarist teachers' set themselves up for success - and quite a few tricks for the trained guitarists as well! We will discuss steps to stay ahead of the students: playing, technique, reading, repertoire, and curriculum.

Theorbo Practices

• A basic introduction to the instrument, it's tuning, and basics of continuo playing from a figured bass.

Adaptive Learning Tools Turn Teachers into Super Teachers

• By centralizing resources, capturing student assessment, and supporting fast and slow learners simultaneously, adaptive learning tools help guitar and ukulele teachers focus more of their time on high-value instruction and less on tedious, boring tasks. This session dives into classroom examples from teachers using adaptive learning tools and techniques to highlight the benefits for teachers, students, and districts.

Come On In, the Water's Fine! Preparing for Your Student Teaching Experience and Beyond

 Attendees will discuss researched strategies and suggestions from administrators, mentor/ cooperating teachers, university supervisors, and former student teachers to prepare to make a "splash" during their student teaching experience and beyond!

If You Can Sing It, You Can Play It - A Brief Overview of Universal Musical Concepts and Rehearsal Techniques

 This session will focus on universal musical concepts and rehearsal techniques that can be applied in the instrumental rehearsal room. This clinic is designed for general music/vocal majors seeking K-12 music certification

Orchestral Survival Guide for Band and Choir Educators


